PM inaugurates Saryu canal project

Invites farmers to watch Dec 16 programme on natural farming

PRIME MINISTER NARENDRA Modi on Saturday invited farmers across the country to watch a mega programme on natural farming on December 16, saying it would prove beneficial for them.

Uttar Pradesh governor Anandiben Patel, chief minister Yogi Adityanath, Union minister for Jal Shakti Gajendra Singh Shekhawat, deputy chief minister Keshav Prasad Maurya were among those present at the project inauguration programme.

Farmers head back home after year-long stir on Delhi border

SINGING, DANCING AND cheering atop their tractor-trolleys, farmers on Saturday began their journey home from Delhi borders after dismantling their tents and other structures at the end of a year-long sit-in against the agrilaws and were accorded a rousing welcome with sweets and garlands in the neighbouring states. Emotions ran high as the farmers performed ardas (prayers) and havans to thank the almighty and set off towards Punjab, Haryana and Uttar Pradesh in convoys of tractors, bedecked with colourful flowers and lights and blaring songs of victory. By 4 pm, less than a quarter of the protesters were left at the Singhu border. Similarly, at the Ghazipur border, the process of dismantling shelters was in full swing, but the protesting farmers said the site will be completely vacated by December 15. Their furrowed faces now lit with smiles, the protesters said they can finally unite with their families.

"But the fact that I am heading home after victory is something I am particularly proud about," said Singh, while on his way back to his home in Uttar Pradesh's Bijnor district on a tractor-trolley with other villagers who were on a sit-in at Ghazipur border.

Genova Biopharma phase III trials of mRNA-based Covid vax to end in January

GENNOVA BIOPHARMACEUTICALS, A subsidiary of Pune-based Emcure Pharmaceuticals, is nearing completion of its phase II-III trials of their mRNA-based Covid-19 vaccine. Samit Mehta, president, Emcure, said they were expecting to complete trials in January 2022. The company has applied for manufacturing and stock piling of the vaccines at risk, Mehta said.

store and minus 20 degrees which is not suitable for India or emerging countries, Mehta said. The vaccines would also cost lower than the existing global vaccines, he said.

With the new Omicron variant emerging and efficacy of existing vaccines against the variant unclear, the company would be looking at the demand for booster doses. The company has started looking at this internally and the government is also pushing us to look at it, Mehta said.

Global data suggests that mRNA vaccines being effective booster doses and also safe for pediatric vaccination, he said. This will follow once the basic vaccine is approved. Once the Indian Emergency Use Authorisation comes, the company would also look at a World Health Organization listing as protocol is designed such a way that WHO mandates so it could expedite the process.

Genova was also working on the freeze drying technology that enables storage of their mRNA vaccine at 2 degrees to 7 degrees Celsius. The other mRNA vaccines available globally need to be

population so the market will be there for the vaccine.

The focus is to get the emergency use authorisation done and that will open up the market, Thapar said. The mRNA vaccine can be tweaked to deal with new mutations and spikes like the Omicron in a short period of time compared to the other vaccines, Thapar said.

Companies like ours will have a role to play even if the pandemic becomes endemic, he said. Booster dose, pediatric dose and mix and match of doses would only need a small bridging study, Thapar said.

The Drug Controller General of India had approved Phase II and Phase III study the vaccine in August.

Genova will submit the data to the DCGI and then it will be decided by the Vaccine Subject Expert Committee.

Emcure has repurposed vaccine manufacturing capacity to make the mRNA Covid-19 vaccines.

It has an installed capacity to make 200 million doses that can be scaled up to one billion doses. Genova has invested around ₹500 crore in the project including ₹125-crore funding from the government as seed capital and for conducting trials.
